

ORDINANCE NO. 2 -2006

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING NO PARKING SIGNS  
AND PROHIBITTING PARKING ON SCHOOL STREET

WHEREAS, pursuant to its authority pursuant to Section 2328 of the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. Section 67328), and also 75 Pa. C.S.A. Section 3353, 6109, and 6122, in the interests of the Township and by exercise of its police powers, hereby authorizes the posting of no parking signs and prohibits parking along both sides of T-406 (School Street), from the intersection of SR-3001 (Newton Ransom Boulevard) to the dead end of T-406 (School Street).

WHEREAS, in accordance with its authority as stated above, the Township has determined it appropriate and in the best interest of the Township to prohibit parking and to post no parking signs along the referenced section of T-406 (School Street), including because parking along the referenced roadway has caused congestion and safety concerns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Newton Township Board of Supervisors, that:

Section 1. From the effective date of this Ordinance, parking shall be prohibited along both sides of T- 406 (School Street), from the intersection of SR-3001 (Newton Ransom Boulevard) to the dead end of T-406 (School Street);


Section 2. The Township shall erect and install appropriate no parking signs in accordance with applicable state regulations;

Section 3: Any person violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and subject to a fine up to \$50.00 and other appropriate remedies as allowed by state law (including removal of the vehicle at the vehicle owner's expense).

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following adoption and enactment by the Board of Supervisors as reflected below.
