DPW Hire: Discussion ensued regarding the hiring of a third full-time DPW worker.

Ron Ezzo – Upper Maple Drive: Mr. Ezzo was present to discuss the cleaning of ditches on Upper Maple Drive. The township will have our engineer visit the site and give recommendation on what can be done.

Recreation Center: The township has notified daydramers that their lease will terminate the end of June, 2022 with no rate increase. The phone and mail for the rec center has been temporarily forwarded to the township office. Carol Mielnikowski will serve as manager in the interim. It hasn't been decided if the center will open. Carol is looking into the heating system. The extension of the lease has to be in writing and signed with daydreamers.

Standing Committee Reports: POSTED - Planning Commission

Road Master: Naegele discussed that the DPW is working on potholes, ditch clean outs and mowing. The loader is not working. It was discussed that they will repair the O rings and order the box since it will take until January to come in. If the O ring kit fixes the issue we will cancel the order on the box.

NRVFC: Chief LaCoe reported that the fire company had a total of 39 calls for the month of July.

Solicitor: Shiels discussed that the Pileggi appeal has been dismissed by the court. We are moving forward with the update to our ACT 537.

Bills: Motion by Carr to approve the bills as read and prepared, 2nd by Naegele.
