Lesh Subdivision: Mrs. Lesh sold a lot and found out her septic and half of her home were in that lot. Remaining acreage – for Bird 3.92 to 3.74 acres and for Lesh 1.57 acres to 1.39 acres. This is a lot-line adjustment. Lackawanna County has plans but the review is not back yet. Concerns of the Planning Commission is if the septic line is 10 feet from the property line. Surveyor, Eric Kyttle, will forward a PDF to the township to guarantee lot line is allowed distance from septic to confirm. Motion by Sartori to recommend approval contingent upon comments from the County and confirmation of 10-foot setback from property line, 2nd by McMinn. Motion voted, all in favor. Surveyor will state on plans to Supervisors that the setback for the septic is 10 feet from property line.
